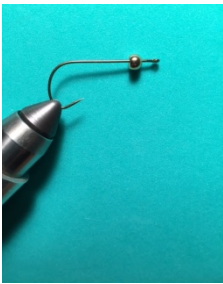

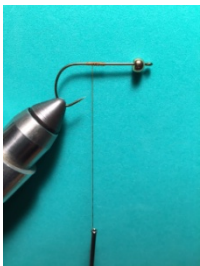
## October Fly of the Month

Step 1. Put bead head on hook



Step 2. Tie thread on hook



Step 3. Tie rabbit strip onto hook

Step 4. Tie on crazy yarn



Step 5. Wrap crazy yarn on hook and tie off



Step 6. Place silly legs on hook



Step 7. Tie in silly legs

Step 8. Tie in red saddle hackle small end first



Step 9. Wrap saddle hackle and tie down



Step 10. Trim silly legs. Go catch a bass!!! Here's the completed fly:
