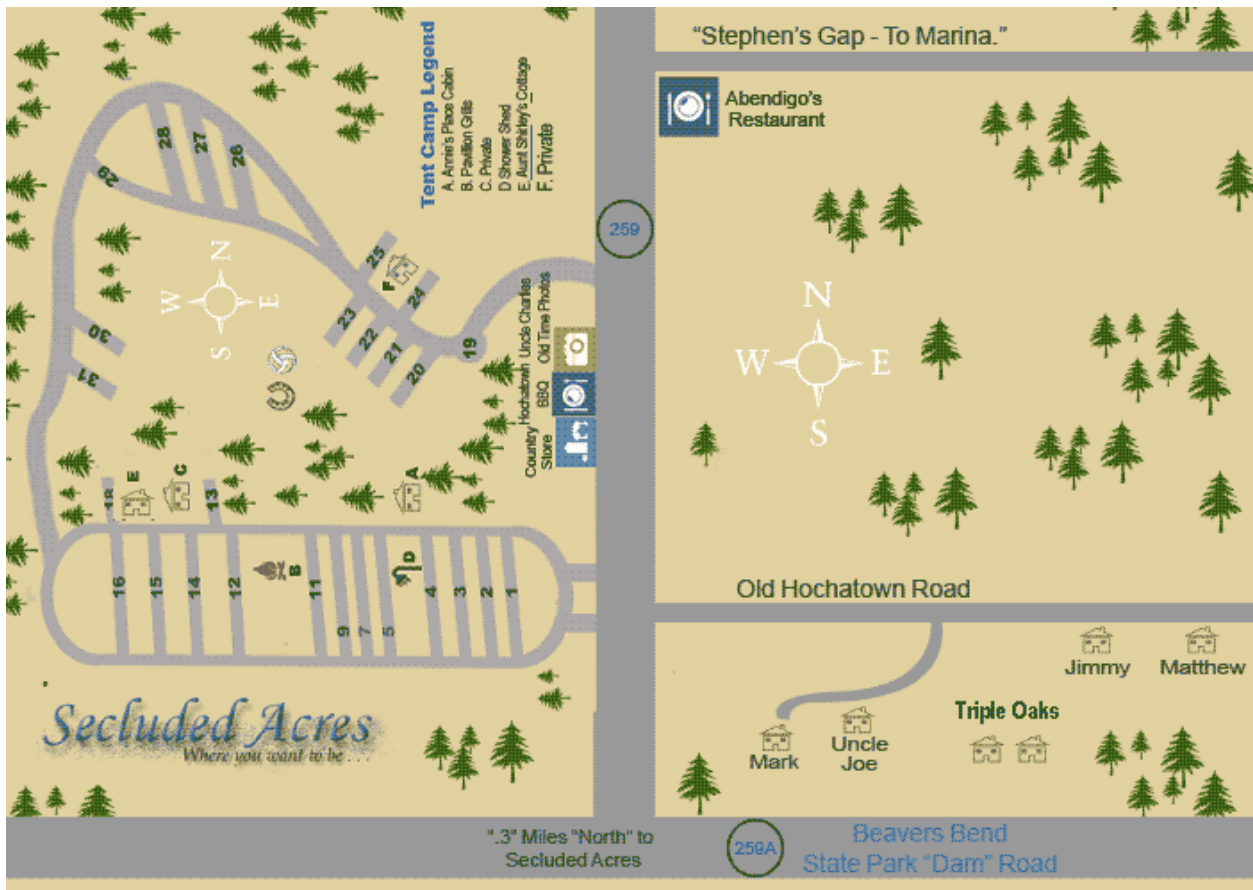
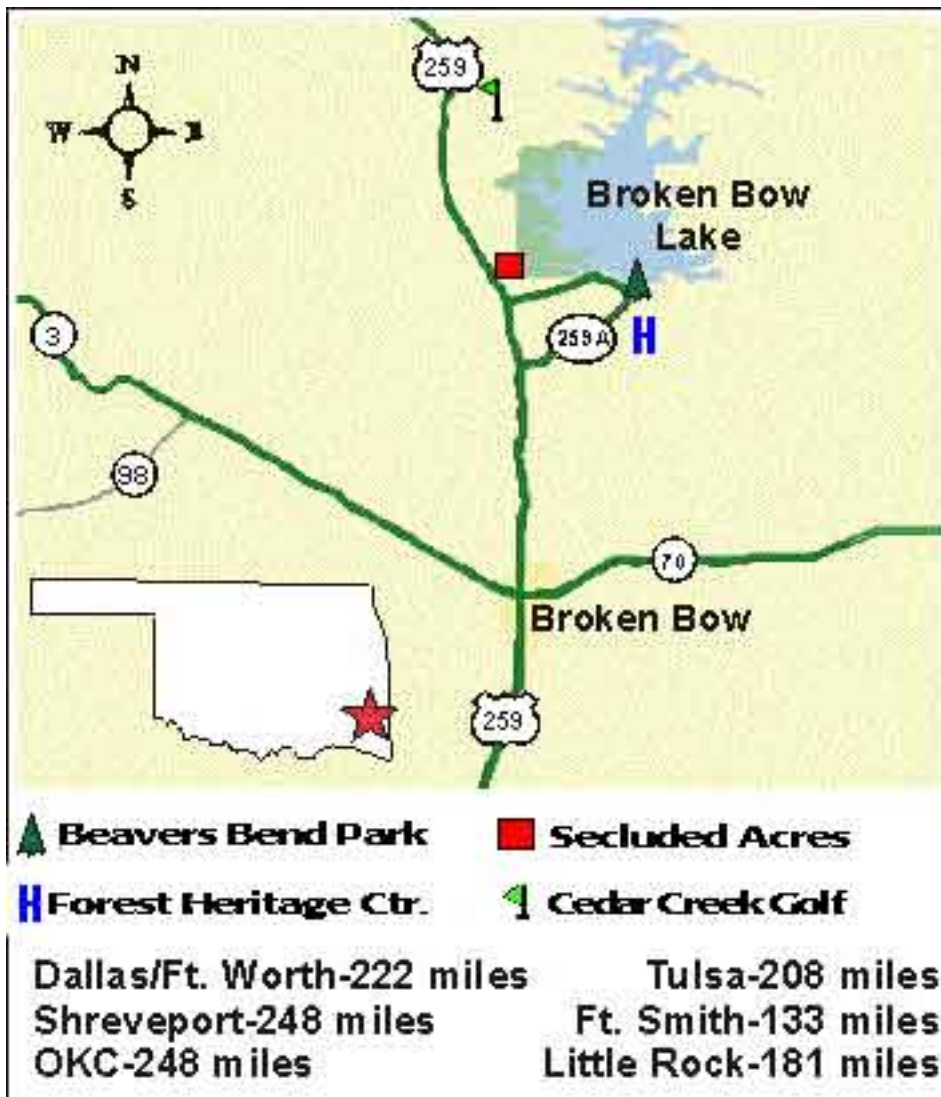


## FWFF Broken Bow Outing December 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>.

The December outing will be the Lower Mountain Fork River, Bevers Bend State Park, near Broken Bow Oklahoma. We will stay at Secluded Acres – We have Mark and Jimmy cabins reserved (<http://www.beaversbendsecludedacres.com>). We need to hear from you as soon as possible so we can ensure accommodations. The cost for two nights is somewhere in the range of \$50 to \$75 depending on the number of folks who sign up.

**Directions to Secluded Acres Cabins:** Highway 259 - North of Broken Bow – Secluded Acres Cabins are on Old Hochatown Road 2.3 miles north of the main entrance to Beavers Bend Park. About a mile north of the main entrance there's another entrance – the Dam Road entrance into the park (also 259A- Note that 259A turns right into the park. Don't turn in). Continue north on 259 – Secluded Acres Country Store will be on your left. Come into the store to check in or if you are a late arrival, come on down to the cabins on Old Hochatown Road (see map below).





We will probably go out to eat both Friday and Saturday nights at some fabulous restaurants in the area. Or do a pot-luck (to be determined). Cabins have a kitchenette so you can plan for breakfast in the cabins and take a sack lunch to the river.

Please let us know by November 20<sup>th</sup> to ensure you have a place to bunk (the earlier the better).
