## Brazos Outdoor Center Rules & Regulations

For your safety and enjoyment of Brazos
Outdoor Center please observe the following rules:

- 1. No Glass Containers allowed.
- 2. No firearms or fireworks are permitted, including BB guns, air rifles, bow and arrow and paintball guns.
- 3. No metal detectors or removal of river rock allowed.
- 4. Campers must be at least 21 years of age or with a parent or guardian.
- 5. All vehicles must be street legal to be operated in BOC. No ATV's, Golf Carts or Go-Carts, etc...
- 6. Obey speed limits, warning signs and traffic laws.
- 7. No vehicle or camper washing.
- 8. No wading pools, no sprinklers.
- 9. Fires are allowed only in the areas that are designated. CUTTING TREES IN THE CAMPGROUND IS PROHIBITED. DAMAGE TO TREES WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE PARK.
- 10. Camping is allowed in designated areas only.
- 11. No more than 1 wheeled camping unit or 2 tents per site and no more than 6 people per site.
- 12. Quiet time is 10pm-8am. Loud, unnecessary noises and improper conduct are not permitted at any time.
- 13. All pets must be leashed. Visitors with pets that present a threat or disturb other visitors will be asked to remove their pets from the park. Pets cannot be left unattended at any time.
- 14. Primitive campsites are first-come, first-served.
- 15. CHECK OUT TIME FOR CAMPERS IS 11AM.
- 16. Visitors must leave the park by 10pm.
- Please leave campsites clean and in good condition.

No debris or trash left in fire rings. Trash left in fire rings will result in a cleaning fee of \$25 minimum.

Have a good time, but be considerate of your neighbor's rights and please help us keep the campground and river clean!

Campsites will not be sold after dark without prior notification of late arrival.

All sales are final. BOC will not issue refunds due to inclement weather.
