



## Nancy Willette Speaker, Author, Fly Fishing Guide & Instructor Biography & Experience

A willow branch, a stretch of line and a glob of leftover "Fig Newton" on a hook, launched Nancy's fishing career in 1964 on one of Minnesota's 10,000 lakes. Hooking and landing a three-pound bass on the Fig Newton and makeshift rod at the age of four, hooked her for life.

By the age of nine Nancy was fishing daily and honing her skills on blue gill, bass, crappie, northern pike, and walleye. Her fly fishing career began in 19 when a 22 lb. king salmon *took her* for a swim. Since that first fly-fishing experience she has filmed and fished throughout the world, and of course her home waters of Minnesota.

She enjoys relating through metaphor and analogy the humorous, inspiring and taxing lessons of fly fishing and the outdoors with professional growth. "Watching that light bulb come on as people make connections with their own life or make their first untangled cast or catch their first fish is very exciting". Her mission is to challenge, inspire and ignite a passionate pursuit of work [and life] through an outdoors and fly-fishing format.
